ATC Economic Planning Timeline and Overview

- January ATC collects data and analyzes prior year congestion.
- February Initial Stakeholder meeting.
 - Congestion summary, background and potential fixes
 - Economic study scenarios, drivers, ranges and assumptions
 - Future meeting dates scheduled
- By March 1st, Stakeholders prioritize and/or request new/other economic studies, as well as recommended study assumptions.
- By **April 15**th, ATC posts preliminary projects list and assumptions.
- By **April 30**th, Stakeholders provide comments on projects list and assumptions.
- By May 15th, ATC posts final projects list and assumptions
- 180 days of analysis and interaction.
- By November 15th, ATC posts final results. Viable projects move on to CA/CPCN approval process.
